Child Care Guidelines

- Child care will have a capacity of 8 children, ages 3 to 5 years old, during an in-person, parent-only class. All children in child care, will be required to wear their own mask as provided by the parent.
- A maximum of 2 children per parent will be allowed in child care until capacity has been reached.
- Parents will need to follow social distancing guidelines (6 feet apart) while signing in/out their children at the table outside the Child Care Room. Parents will not be allowed in the Child Care Room.
- Water bottles for children will be available throughout the duration of the class. Snacks or personal items for children will not be permitted in the Child Care Room.
- Once in child care, children will be instructed to wash their hands. All staff and children in the Child Care Room will be required to wear masks; therefore, social distancing practices will not be required.
- Parents who are interested in attending an in-person, parent-only class with their child in the classroom will need to make a request to Thrive to Five staff at the time of registration.
- All tables, chairs, and toys used during child care will be disinfected by Thrive to Five staff before and after use.
- Registration for child care is required when registering for an in-person class. Walk-ins will not be permitted.
 - Anyone who does not agree to adhere to these guidelines is encouraged to explore our available online classes.
